I am pleased to inform you that the parish donation has been forwarded to the *Sister Disciples of the Divine Master* here in Ouagadougou who, alongside their liturgical apostolate, are also responsible for the *Mother Scholastique formation centre* that trains girls and young women in activities such as sewing, embroidery and cookery so that they may be equipped with professional skills to make a livelihood. In addition, the centre also provides remedial courses in reading and writing, as many of the girls and young women, because of extreme poverty, were not able to attend primary or secondary level education.

In accepting the generous gift of the Parish of Ballyhea, Sr. Marguerite Kaboré, Delegate of the *Sister Disciples of the Divine Master* in Burkina Faso, has asked me to extend the gratitude of the sisters for this greatly appreciated donation which will contribute to this noble and much needed apostolate to socially and economically marginalised girls and young women.
