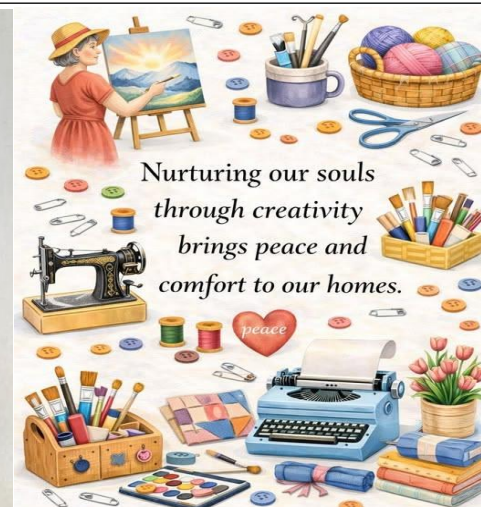


The Annual Padre Pio Ceremonies commemorating his
